

Welcome Home Niagara Home Ownership Program

Please review all eligibility criteria before completing application

Applicant Eligibility Criteria:

Applicants must:

- Be over the age of 18
- Be a Canadian Citizen, Landed Immigrant or have Refugee Claimant Status with no outstanding removal order
- Have been renting in the Niagara region for at least the last six months as a "Renter Household" (applicants paying room and board or living with family or friends are not eligible)
- Have an annual household gross income of \$83,800 or less for all members of the household (applicants must disclose if on a temporary leave returning to full time work, e.g. Maternity Leave)
- Provide Notice of Assessment for each household member over the age of 18
- Qualify for a mortgage from a federally recognized bank or financial institution and provide verification (applicants who require the assistance of a co-signer or guarantor are not eligible)
- Have personal assets of less than \$30,000 which includes RRSPs as well as any gifted amounts from family or friends
- Be able to cover all closing costs and legal fees associated with purchasing a home
- Not currently own a home or property and intend for this home to be their sole and principal residence
- Submit a completed application with all required documents. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed for eligibility and will be returned to the applicant.

Household Eligibility Criteria:

- The household must be located in the Niagara region
- The home may be new or resale (a home inspection is required at buyers cost for all resale homes)
- The purchase price of the home must not exceed \$405,930 (Maximum Purchase Price subject to change as per update from Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing)
- The home must be modest in size and features
- Cannot be a home in which the buyer or any member of the buyers family has ownership interest
- Homes must be single residential units which may include detached, semi-detached, condominiums, townhouses or row houses
- Mobile homes are not eligible
- Multi-residential properties such as duplexes and triplexes are not eligible
- The Agreement of Purchase and Sale must be dated after the approval and Conditional Letter of Commitment from Niagara Regional Housing

Please Note: There are a limited number of households that can be served with the available funding. Some of the funding will be designated for applicants currently living in Social Housing.
