

FACT SHEET

Description

Since 2002 Niagara Regional Housing (NRH) has been the administrator of affordable housing for Niagara Region. NRH is governed by a community-based Board of Directors who report to the Council of the Niagara Region. Our services are focused on opening doors for the citizens of Niagara through a continuum of affordable housing options, including single-family dwellings, townhouses and apartment communities for seniors, individuals and families.

Through our Affordable Housing Waiting List, Niagara Regional Housing ensures fair and equal access for applicants to more than 7,700 units of affordable housing in NRH-owned communities, non-profit and co-operative housing and in participating private rental units. Once housed, NRH partners with community agencies to deliver ongoing support to tenants in order to maintain successful tenancies.

Applicants interested in joining the NRH Board of Directors should have a genuine interest in affordable housing, attend all meetings and be prepared to participate on Board committees.
