The CPC for Landlords works with individuals and households on a voluntary basis to:

- help tenants avoid eviction by working with them to resolve the issues that have caused the risk of eviction
- provide supports and referrals to help improve lives (e.g. support for aging in place, mental health/addiction counselling, parenting classes, etc.)
- mediate social issues between neighbours
- and more...

Who is eligible?

- tenants and Rent Supplement landlords in Niagara

Who can refer?

Tenants can refer themselves or **Rent Supplement Landlords** can refer a tenant by:
