



# Energy Conservation Program

## FACT SHEET

### Purpose

Niagara Regional Housing (NRH) is committed to ensuring that energy conservation measures are implemented when possible to promote environmentally sustainable conservation practices

### Description

NRH has made many significant energy upgrades. Recent energy conservation capital programs included:

- Installation of compact fluorescent light bulbs
- Removal of T-12 lighting and installation of T-8 lighting in hallways of various buildings (ongoing)
- Limiting thermostats (78 F / 22 C maximum temperature setting)
- Replacement to energy efficient refrigerators
- Bathroom upgrades, including low flow toilets, shower heads and tap sets
- Higher efficiency furnace replacements
- Replacement of front and back doors from wooden to magnetically sealed steel doors

### Role of Tenants

- Reduce temperature when possible
- Turn off unnecessary lights
- Clean or replace the air filter on the furnaces
- Reduce water consumption
- Recycle
- Conserve energy whenever possible

### Role of Niagara Regional Housing

- Raise awareness of energy conservation within NRH communities
- Continue to investigate and implement energy conservation measures that set an example of environmental stewardship within our communities
