WHAT IS URGENT STATUS?

Urgent status may be assigned to an application if a member of the household experiences one of the following:

1. Physical limitations and their health is significantly compromised because the building they are living in does not have an elevator and they are required to climb stairs to get to their unit.
2. Extreme hardship where the individual's situation puts them at extreme risk and/or causes extreme hardship and relocation would reduce the risks and/or alleviate the hardship.

A letter from a doctor/medical professional/support agency is required to verify and confirm one of the above statements.

The following circumstances **will not** be considered for Urgent status: homelessness, police issues, financial reasons, pregnancy, medical issues not affected by current accommodation, landlord issues such as accessibility requirements, maintenance issues, bed bugs, ants, other insects, verbal abuse by landlord, neighbours, loud noise.
