SUBJECT: Redeveloping Social Housing in Ontario: A Provincial Guide and Perspective

Background

In response to the growing interest shown by housing providers in redeveloping their social housing portfolios, the Housing Division of the Ministry of Municipal Affairs & Housing has developed a guide called “Redeveloping Social Housing in Ontario: A Provincial Guide and Perspective” for service managers and housing providers.

The guide describes the roles and responsibilities of the housing provider, service manager and Ministry, as well as provides some key considerations for housing providers interested in redevelopment.

Please note it is not the intent of this document to be the definitive step-by-step guide as each redevelopment situation is different. But rather, the intent is to educate and raise awareness on some of the areas where the province is involved in redevelopment, and to provide clarification on the provincial role in social housing and social housing redevelopment.

Housing Provider’s Role
