Subject: Senior Citizens Government Pension Income (Oct. 1, 2018 – Dec. 31, 2018)

Background:

The Ministry of Finance has issued the new levels for the Guaranteed Annual Income System (GAINS) for Ontario senior citizens.

The amounts are set out below for your reference and represent the maximum guaranteed monthly income amounts payable to eligible senior citizens for the period October 1, 2018 to December 31, 2018.

Benefit Period: October 1, 2018 – December 31, 2018

Guaranteed Income Level	Monthly	Annually
Single Pensioners	\$1,581.27	\$ 18,975.24
Qualified Couples, Per Person	\$1,224.08	\$ 14,688.96
