

Community Programs Coordinator (for Housing Provider & Rent Supplement Tenants)

Are you worried about being evicted from your home?

Are you having problems getting along with your landlord or neighbours?

Are you experiencing stress that is affecting your physical and/or mental health?

If you answered yes to any of the questions above, your Community Programs Coordinator (CPC) may be able to help! The CPC works with individuals and households on a voluntary basis to:

- help tenants/members avoid eviction by working with them to resolve the issues that have caused the risk of eviction
- provide supports and referrals to help improve lives (e.g. support for aging in place, mental health/addiction counselling, parenting classes, etc.)
- mediate social issues between neighbours
- and more...

Who is eligible?

- Tenants/Members living in Housing Provider (Non-Profits, Cooperatives) and Rent Supplement units

Who can refer?
