**SUBJECT:** Household Income Limits - 2014

#### **BACKGROUND**

The new Housing Services Act 2011 came into effect on January 1, 2012. Several regulations accompanied the new legislation, one of which was Ontario Regulation 370/11 which provides the new High Need and Household Income Limits.

Effective January 1, 2014, the following household income limits apply:
